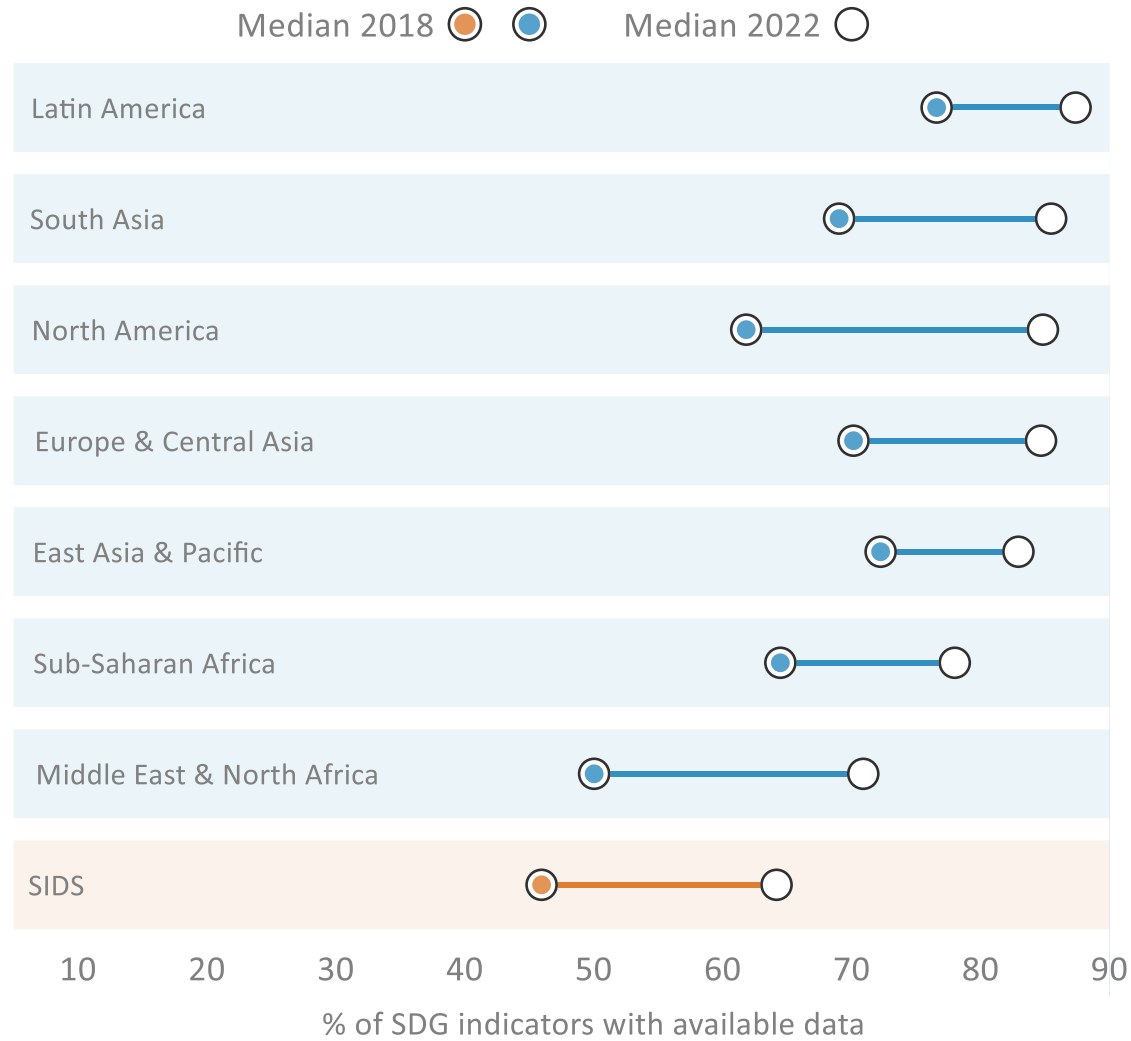

LA: 87%

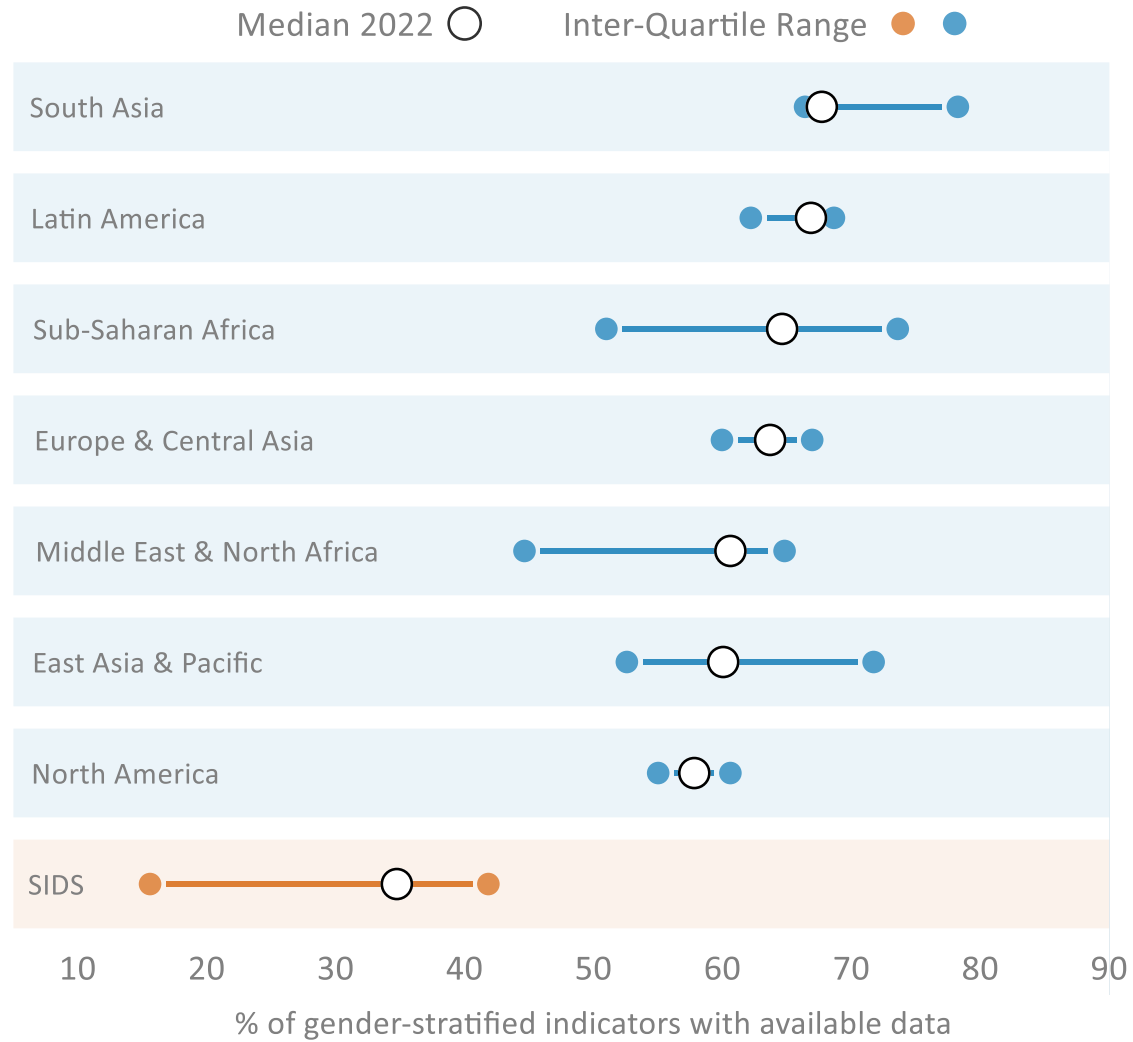


SSA: 78%
