### **CaribData Steering Committee Meeting Summary**

#### Feb 25, 2025

# 1. Opening and Agenda

- Ian Hambleton opened the meeting and outlined the agenda.
- Selvie was to provide a short update on progress since the last Steering Committee meeting, noting that there was no face-to-face in November.
- An email update had been shared earlier.
- The main focus of the session was a presentation from Chris and the Angry Health team on the **training component** of the CaribData project.

## 2. Project Updates (by Selvie)

- Component 1 (Infrastructure): A readiness assessment consultant has been hired. They are working on a 2025 work plan.
  - o This includes evaluating data storage and storytelling readiness.
  - o Both infrastructure and personnel capacity will be assessed.
  - o The goal is to identify and remove barriers early.
- A demonstration dataset is available on **Zenodo** (open science data platform), but Selvie's update was cut short due to poor connectivity.

## 3. Shift to Training Presentation (Chris, Angry Health)

- With Selvie disconnected, Ian transitioned to the training component discussion, led by Chris.
- Chris explained that Angry Health is responsible for data communication within CaribData.
- Their work spans:
  - Creating data stories
  - o Training in data storytelling
  - o Disseminating stories
  - Developing the business case for data storytelling

## 4. Key Themes of the Training Component

- The training is being designed with 2025 goals in mind.
- It will focus on:
  - o Data storytelling skills
  - o Use of real regional datasets
  - o Building a **network of data storytellers**
- The objective is to enhance data literacy, engagement, and communication capacity within national statistics offices and the wider community.
